### President's Message: Tom Weber

April showers have ended... bring on the May Flowers.

And what do May flowers bring?

NAR Legislative meetings in Washington DC of course! It's that time of year when REALTORS® gather in Washington to lobby for homeowners' rights and programs that protect the housing market. Time to support, in person, the efforts that our RPAC and Direct Giver funds have been supporting.

It's also the meetings when President-elect Stan Hill and I will have time to meet with peers from around the country to gather ideas and contacts to help us continue strengthening our local Association, long into the future. I am looking forward to the busy schedule we will have and all that we will learn.

So, I know you're super interested now... and saying "What are the NAR Legislative issues that you will be discussing with our representatives this year Tom?" Thank you, I am so glad you asked. Here are the three main issues and a couple of the key points in each:

#### Tax Reform

- Reform ideas that repeal or weaken tax incentives to encourage homeownership must be rejected.
- The tax code historically has encouraged homeownership. Proposals that limit interest and property tax deductibility would reverse this course.
- Homeownership provides social benefits to communities, increasing neighborhood stability and community involvement. America must continue to encourage homeownership.

### **National Flood Insurance Program**

- Authority for the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) expires on September 30, 2017.
- Urge Congress to pass a multiyear reauthorization with needed private market reforms to avoid adding uncertainty to real estate markets.
- NFIP should use modern mapping technology to produce building specific risk assessments.
   Currently, homeowners bear the burden of amending the maps.

### Protect Sustainable Homeownership

- Responsibly reform the secondary mortgage market to ensure that the qualified borrowers have access to safe, affordable mortgage financing.
- Ban the use of mortgage guarantee fees (g-fees) to offset the cost of legislation unrelated to housing.
- Ensure that loans used to pay for energy efficiency improvements are subject to consumer protection laws.

I appreciate the opportunity and am honored that Stan and I will be representing RASCW and all of you in Washington DC on these important issues and learning valuable information from our peer meetings. We hope to be bringing lots of fresh ideas for consideration by our members and Board of Directors.

I hope you will consider joining me for a couple of great upcoming RASCW events:

New Developments for Commercial Brokers 2017 coming up on May 24th. It is always a very informative morning learning about the latest commercial developments in process throughout our communities

Safety First! Protecting Yourself in the Physical and Digital World on June 1st. ### Offer-Show Must Be Available to Show

If your listing is in the status of Offer-Show, you must allow showings. Please keep in mind that the status of Offer-Show displays on public websites as well as in the MLS. When a consumer sees the label Offer-Show, they are expecting to be able to see that property. It reflects badly on your profession as a whole when the consumer is denied a showing on a property that is clearly marked as Offer-Show. If you are no longer showing a property that has an offer, please move it to Offer- No Show immediately.

### Need Help with your Computer?

As a member of the WRA, you now have access to a new hotline available to help with technology problems. While we at the MLS are available to help you with Paragon™, Supra, WIREX, ShowingAssist and listing syndication, we do not have staff available to help solve problems with computer hardware, operating systems, or internet browsers. You can now contact the WRA Tech Hotline for help with many technology problems. Hours are M-F 8-7 and S 8-4. You will need your WRA member ID, which can be found on the label of your monthly Wisconsin Real Estate Magazine. The April issue of this magazine includes detailed info about this new service. ### eKEY App and Your New Phone

Don't forget about your eKEY app when you upgrade your phone. When upgrading, you will need to reinstall the eKEY app and reauthorize via a new 30-digit code. Authorization codes are available from the following sources:

To make it easier to get technical help from Supra Tech Support, have your eKEY serial number handy. Hot Tip: save the Supra Tech Support phone number (877-699-6787) as a contact in your phone, and add your serial number as a note in the contact file. You can find your serial number at the top of your eKEY screen (eKEY Basic-1234567).

### Make Use of the Paragon™ Calendar

By default, there is a calendar in the lower right corner of the Paragon™ home page. Those with broker/manager/administrative access can post events for display on their agents' calendars. Click the green plus sign to add an event. Enter the event title, location and select Personal, Office or Firm. Selecting Office will display the event to just those in your branch office. Selecting Firm will display the event to all agents in your company. Those with agent level access can post personal reminders. If you utilize the Tasks feature within the Paragon™ Contact Manager (located under More Information within the contact), these tasks will display on your Paragon™ calendar as personal reminders.
