Affordable Housing Equal Opportunities Committee

This committee focuses on expanding home ownership for minorities and people with disabilities through scholarship programs, home buyer education, increasing affordable housing opportunities for all people, providing association members with tools such as wheelchair ramps for home showings to clients with disabilities and information on recent fair housing law developments.

Commercial Services Committee

This committee addresses how the Association can better serve our commercial practitioners. We encourage those members who work primarily in the commercial area to join and be involved.

Ghoulish Gallop Committee

This committee plans the annual event that raises funds for the Realtors® Association of South Central Wisconsin Housing Foundation in support of its efforts to provide down payment and closing cost assistance to qualified home buyers.
