RASCW To Host ADU Design Competition

Madison, WI – The REALTORS® Association of South-Central Wisconsin ([RASCW](#)) will be hosting a housing design competition with a cash reward thanks to funding provided by [AARP](#) through the [Community Challenge](#) grant program*.

This Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) design competition will be hosted on October 23rd during Madison’s Housing Week which runs from October 19th to the 25th. The top three winning designs will receive a monetary award of \$3,000 for their designs and \$500 will be awarded to the top student design. This will increase housing accessibility while helping to lower the cost of building an ADU as well as making the public more aware of how ADUs can benefit our community.

All are invited to submit designs that meet the requirements including city ordinances. The designs will be based on a preexisting lot and will need to consist of a floor plan, elevation and a 3D rendering. These designs will be judged by a panel of experts consisting of a RASCW member, an architect, a local elected official and a City of Madison expert.

Design submissions will open on September 15th and will close on October 10th with the finalists being notified on October 17th.

The public is invited to view the finalist’s designs and discuss with the designers on October 23rd from 5:00pm to 7:00pm at Starting Block located at 821 East Washington Ave, Madison, WI 53703. After the presentation of the top five designs, the judges panel will announce the three winners.
